AMC Miles Matter was founded by a Carlsbad family whose son, Lucas, was born with AMC in February 2012. Lucas was diagnosed at his mom's 20-week ultrasound. His parents were told that his condition "wasn't compatible with life outside the womb." Arthrogryposis Mulitplex Congenita (AMC) is a rare muscle and joint condition that occurs one in every 3,000 live births. Although those numbers seem common, very few people are aware of AMC. The condition involves curved or hooked joints, limited range of motion and multiple joint contractures throughout the body at birth. There is no cure for AMC, but treatments are available to help those with the condition lead happy, independent lives. Treatments include serial casting, physical therapy, occupational therapy and various surgeries.
